6. ECS staff are providing training opportunities and webinar information to help further support staff.
7. ECS staff are providing support for compliance plans and for CDA renewals.
8. ECS staff have provided subrecipients with fillable enrollment forms to be used for enrollment.
9. Sanilac Great Start Collaborative continues to ensure a coordinated early childhood (prenatal-8) infrastructure and programming.
10. Sanilac Great Start Collaborative ensures that all activities will be guided by the Great Start Strategic Plan Action Agenda with amendments that will accommodate social distancing and all other COVID-19 safeguards.
